Pastor's Page



“Word Volley”

My youngest daughter decided to play 7th grade volleyball for the first time this year. For those who don't truly understand the world of girl's 7th grade volleyball, no worries. As a former wrestler, I feel qualified to help. Here are some rules as I've observed them.

After every point a team scores all the girls on the scoring team are required to shout out loud, except the individual who last touched the ball. At only 12-13 years old, she must attempt a primitive roar. Immediately after, the scoring team gathers together in the center of their court to remind each other that they should continue to do whatever they just did.

If one team calls a time out, the opposing team must cheer for joy. Clearly, the coach calling the time out needs to convey a new strategy to her team like, “Try hitting the ball over the net.”

In order to confuse absolutely everyone involved, players frequently yell the word “over.” Paradoxically, “over” means, “the ball is coming at us.” It also means, “The ball now must go at them.” Therefore, I've concluded that “over” really means, “Attention! Prepare to do something!” However, when the

opposing team is serving a ball and it appears that the ball will not make it over the net, the receiving team yells, “Short!” This means “Attention! Prepare to do nothing.”

The coach often yells, “Keep talking.” Seems unnecessary. It is a girl's sport. Every good play is followed by a chant like, “Awww, ace!” Or, “Slam, reload!” Then the chant, which started on the court, is immediately echoed by the players on bench because... well, I actually have no idea. I can't even conjure up a reason why this should happen. Further, anything said on the court has to be said 3 times. “Over, over, over! Short, short, short!” My theory is this. They're tapping into the power of their formative years. If I was told three times... I needed to do something right now and it better be good.

God's messages are often calls to action. Sometimes they're encouragement. Sometimes they're just for you. Sometimes they're something only you will understand, in the context of your own life. Sometimes they're hard to understand. At times they may even seem paradoxical. God keeps talking. He keeps communicating. As a loving father, He's preparing us- for both the seen and the unseen. It's been my experience that those who refuse to listen risk missing the ball, maybe even the game all together. Listen, get ready, then respond appropriately. Here, at Lindsey, you're surrounded with a team to help you along the way.

Our goal is to ship over 200 boxes!

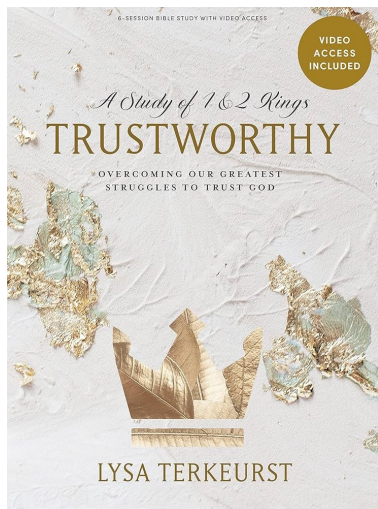

Our next women's bible study will kick off on **Sunday, October 27** and together we will dive into Lysa TerKeurst's series called "Trustworthy: A Study of 1 & 2 Kings."

to tame God, not trust Him. It's then that we begin to press into our ways and our own timing. No human can carry the weight of being their own god, but so many of us try."

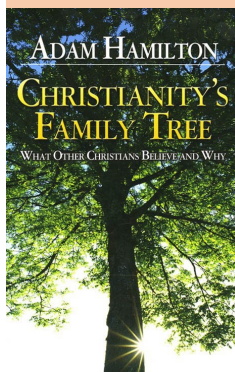

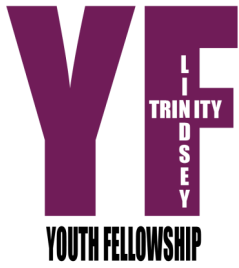


Children's Church
